

Processing Narcotic RX's

Put the RX in as you normally would. When you commit then save and continue you will get an additional window to authorize the RX.

Click the check mark under confirm then "sign now" will light up and click that.

After clicking "sign now" another window opens. The user name looks weird but don't change it that is the name that was created when your account was setup. The password will be your ALLSCRIPTS PASSWORD (the one you logged into the system with). From the device drop down choose the device you are using to get your one time passcode (token, phone) and then enter the code that you generate from that device. If you are using a cell phone app you might want to let the first code expire and regenerate. We have found that sometimes the first code doesn't work. Once you have entered all the information then the "Authenticate" button will light up green. Click "Authenticate" to send the RX.

If you get any errors after clicking "Authenticate" (ex. invalid user name or password) try reentering your password. Remember it's your ALLSCRIPTS Password and also make sure you have selected the correct device for the code you entered. If you try too many times it could lock you out of Allscripts then you would call x9801 to get unlocked. Also sometimes if you back out completely and start the RX process over it will then process.
