

## Chart Alert for MSSP ACO PATIENT

With Starling's participation in the ACO, there are a panel of patients that are attributed to our group. Upon receipt of Starling's attributed patients from CMS, chart alerts were added for a visual cue. Any attributed patient has a chart alert of MSSP ACO PATIENT that can be seen on the patient banner. A random sampling by CMS of these patients will have ACO quality measures reported to them as a requirement of Starling's ACO participation.
